Plain Language Summary of Financial Assistance Policy

As part of its contribution of resources, advocacy and community support to promote the health status of the community which it serves, the hospital will provide financial assistance to patients with a demonstrated inability to pay for medically necessary services in accordance with the hospital's Financial Assistance Policy.

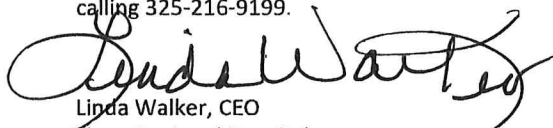
All patients (including those with insurance) may apply for financial assistance by submitting a completed financial assistance application in accordance with the instructions on the application. The patient's situation will be evaluated according to relevant circumstances, such as income, assets, or other resources available to the patient or the patient's family and the amount of the outstanding balance. It is ultimately the patient's responsibility to provide the necessary information to qualify for financial assistance. There is no assurance that the patient will qualify for financial assistance.

Established eligibility criteria and discount guidelines will be used to determine what amount, if any, of an outstanding patient account balance qualifies for financial assistance. Patients whose yearly household income is above 300% but not more than 700% of FPG are eligible to receive services at a discounted amount.

No patient who qualifies for financial assistance will be charged more for emergency or other medically necessary care than amounts generally billed to patients having insurance.
